

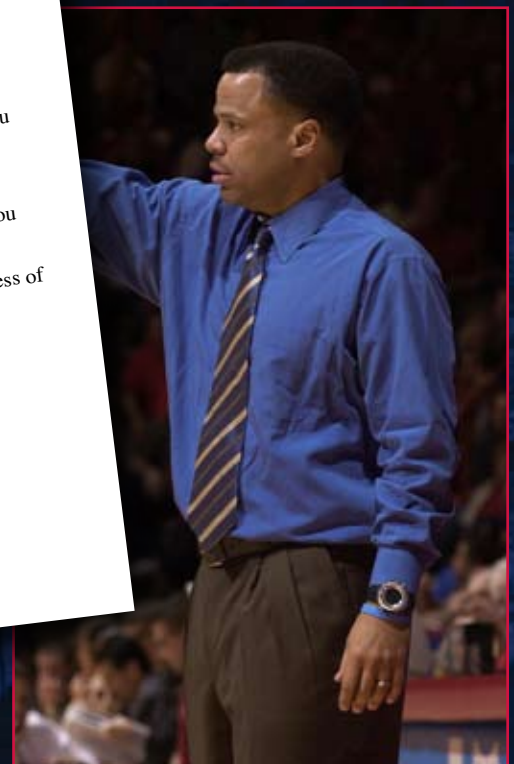

Auburn will be only the second SEC men's or women's basketball team ever to play at the Vines Center. Tough battles like that will help prepare our team for the first-ever 16-game Big South season.

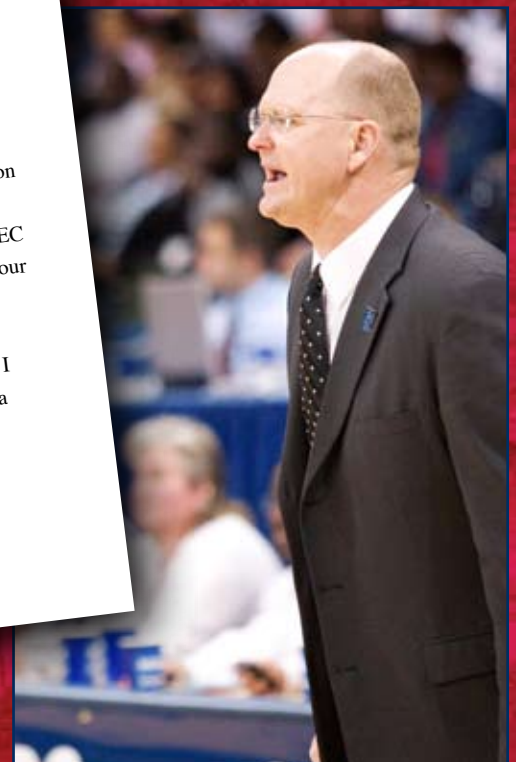

You can guarantee your own reserved seat for every game, and enjoy the comfort of high-quality cushioned seating by purchasing Premium Season Tickets.

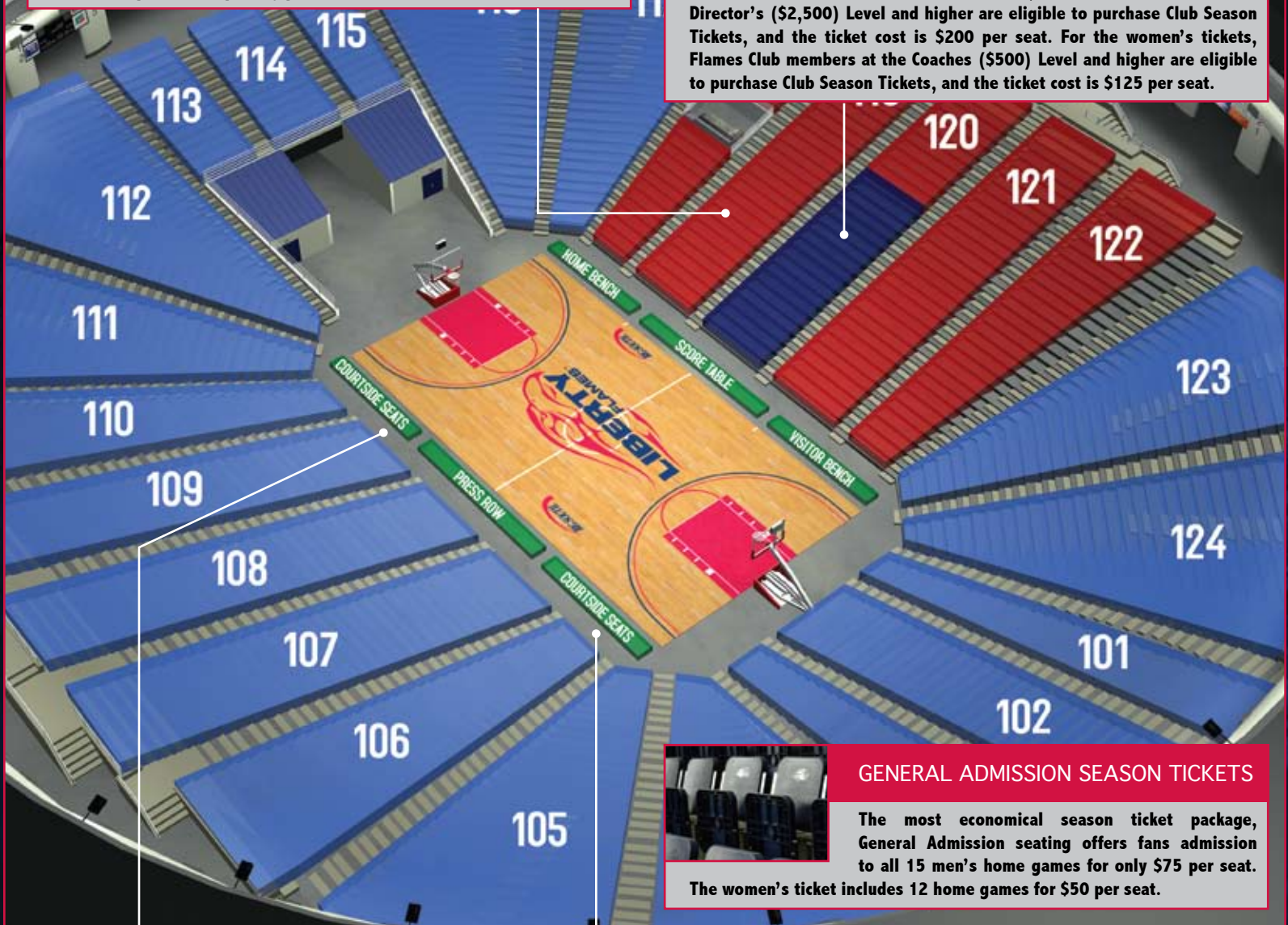

Club seating is new to the Vines Center for 2008-09. These limited deluxe 24-inch seats offer unprecedented comfort for Liberty Basketball, and include waiter service.
