Today's Game

Liberty (5-6) will tip off defense of its Big South Conference regular-season title Saturday at 4:30 p.m., when the Lady Flames travel across the Commonwealth to face Radford (6-5).

The "Starting Five" - Today's Top Storylines

1) Saturday's game will be the 2011-12 Big South Conference opener for both Liberty and Radford, who are expected to be two of the conference's top women's basketball teams this season. Last year, Liberty won the conference regular-season title at 14-2, while Radford tied Gardner-Webb for second place at 11-5. This season, the Lady Flames have been picked as the conference favorite, while the Highlanders came in third in the Big South preseason poll.

2) Liberty will look for its 11th victory in its last 12 Big South openers in an uncommon conference-opening matchup with Radford. The Lady Flames have not tipped off their Big South slate against the Highlanders since Jan. 13, 2004. That day, Liberty posted a 63-45 win inside the Dedmon Center to mark the beginning of a 14-0 run through the 2003-04 Big South regular-season slate.

3) Liberty has faced Radford more often than any other opponent in program history, with Saturday's matchup marking the 56th meeting between the Commonwealth foes. The Lady Flames are 31-24 all-time against Radford, after going 30-4 in their last 34 contests versus the Highlanders.

4) The Lady Flames have been successful at the Dedmon Center in recent years, winning their last four games at Radford by an average of 16.5 ppg.

5) Liberty redshirt senior Avery Warley needs 13 rebounds to break Katie Feenstra's program record of 1,033 career boards. Warley has traditionally fared well against Radford, with three career double-doubles against the Highlanders. Last season, she averaged 16.5 ppg and 13.5 rpg in two meetings with Radford.

-- Radford is the Lady Flames' most commonly-faced opponent in program history, as Saturday's game will mark the teams' 56th meeting.

-- Liberty is 30-4 in its last 34 matchups with the Highlanders, after Radford won 20 of the first 21 contests between the Commonwealth foes.

-- The Lady Flames have been victorious in four consecutive trips to the Dedmon Center, winning the games by an average of 16.5 ppg.

-- Saturday's game will be just the third time Liberty and Radford have ever faced off before the calendar flips to January and the first time since Dec. 10, 1991. That day, the Lady Flames played their first-ever Big South Conference game and came away a 77-70 loser to the Highlanders inside the Dedmon Center.

-- This is the first time Liberty has opened its Big South Conference slate with a contest against Radford since the 2003-04 campaign. The Lady Flames tipped off a perfect 14-0 conference ledger with a 63-45 win at Radford on Jan. 13, 2004.

-- Liberty and Radford both played UNC Greensboro and Virginia during the non-conference portion of the schedule. Both teams defeated the Spartans and lost to the Cavaliers.

-- Liberty and Radford have combined to win 22 of 25 Big South Tournament titles all-time.

Liberty's last game played outside its home state was a matchup against Lipscomb in the consolation contest of the Vanderbilt Thanksgiving Tournament, Nov. 26 in Nashville, Tenn.

A Look Back at Liberty's Loss at Richmond on Dec. 20

-- Liberty cut a 21-point second-half deficit to six, but suffered its third straight road defeat, 66-54.

-- The Lady Flames dropped to 3-20 all-time against Richmond.

-- Liberty outrebounded the Spiders by a 26-19 count after halftime, finishing with a slim 38-37 edge on the glass for the contest. The Lady Flames won the rebounding battle for the 38th straight game.

-- Liberty has now made a three-pointer in all 11 games this season and in 43 straight contests dating back to last season. However, the Lady Flames shot just 5.6 percent (1-of-18) from three-point range at Richmond.

-- The Lady Flames' 15 turnovers were just one off of their season low. Liberty had 14 turnovers against James Madison on Dec. 1.

-- Devon Brown scored 13 of her team-high 17 points during the first half. She passed Cynthia Thomson for 13th place on Liberty's all-time scoring list with 1,061 career points.

-- Meanwhile, Avery Warley tallied 13 of her 16 points after halftime, making all seven of her foul shots after the intermission. Warley catapulted Sharon Snodgrass into seventh place in program history with 1,179 career points.

-- Warley led all players with nine rebounds, giving her 1,021 boards for her career. She needs 13 more rebounds to pass Katie Feenstra for the program record and second place in Big South history.

-- Freshman Catherine Kearney posted all of her statistics (5 points & 3 rebounds) during the second half, helping to spark Liberty's comeback effort.

-- Richmond's Abby Oliver scored a game-high 23 points, including a 10-of-10 effort from the free throw line. That equaled the most foul shots a Liberty opponent has ever made in a single contest without a miss.

Let's Get It Started

-- Saturday's contest marks the first time since the 1996-97 season that Liberty has played its Big South Conference opener during the month of December.

-- That year, Liberty notched a 68-67 home win over UNC Asheville on Dec. 16, 1996. Two and a half months later, the Lady Flames captured their first-ever Big South title with an 89-82 triumph over UNC Greensboro on the same court.

-- Big South Conference play begins earlier this season than it has in recent years, due to all 10 conference teams playing an 18-game conference schedule. This is only the second time (also 1993-94) that Big South women's basketball teams have played 18 conference tilts.

-- In 1993-94, Liberty tied Coastal Carolina for sixth place in the Big South regular-season standings with a 10-8 conference mark.

Early Tests

-- Liberty, which was picked first in the Big South preseason poll for the 14th time in the last 15 years, will face off with two of its top projected contenders right off the bat in conference play.

-- The Lady Flames open their Big South slate at Radford (No. 3 in the preseason poll) on Saturday and then return home to face No. 2 selection High Point on Jan. 7.
