Today's Game

Liberty (1-2) will return home Tuesday at 7 p.m. for an in-state matchup with Virginia-Wise (2-4) at the Vines Center. The Lady Flames will attempt to pick up their first home win of the year and snap their two-game losing streak. It will be Liberty's first contest against Virginia-Wise since Nov. 28, 1994.

The "Starting Five" - Today's Top Storylines

- 1) Liberty and Virginia-Wise are meeting on the hardwood for the first time since Nov. 28, 1994, when Virginia-Wise was known as Clinch Valley. The Lady Flames won that contest at the Vines Center by a 73-53 score.
- 2) This will be Liberty's first game against an NAIA opponent since Dec. 13, 1997, when the Lady Flames notched a 103-61 home win over Cedarville.
- 3) The Lady Flames will aim to avoid their first three-game losing streak since a five-game losing skid spanning Nov. 22-Dec. 7, 2008. Liberty will also try to avoid suffering back-to-back home losses for the first time since Nov. 14 and Dec. 7, 2008.
- 4) Devon Brown will continue her chase for the 1,000-point mark. She enters Tuesday's game with 968 career points, leaving the redshirt junior 32 points shy of the milestone.
- 5) Both Devon Brown and Avery Warley will attempt to continue their respective shooting streaks. Brown has made eight straight free throws, while Warley has connected on her last 10 field goal attempts. Both streaks began during the second half of the VCU game on Nov. 15.

-- Tuesday's game will mark the first time Liberty has faced an NAIA opponent since Dec. 13, 1997, when the Lady Flames posted a 103-61 home win against Cedarville.

-- Liberty (then known as Liberty Baptist College and later Lynchburg Baptist College) was an NAIA member between 1975 and 1984.

-- Virginia-Wise is one of five Liberty opponents this season with a new head coach (also High Point, UNC Greensboro, Virginia and Winthrop).

-- Liberty will play both Virginia and its only branch campus (Virginia-Wise) in the span of 16 days this season.

-- Liberty and Virginia-Wise do not have any opponents in common this year. However, the Cavaliers posted a 57-45 win over Voorhees on Nov. 5. As a point of comparison, Liberty's Big South rival Charleston Southern defeated Voorhees 67-39 on Saturday.

-- In the teams' most recent meeting, Liberty posted a 73-53 win at the Vines Center on Nov. 28, 1994 for the Lady Flames' first home victory of the season. Angie Johnson and Michelle Wyms paced Liberty's balanced scoring attack with 15 points apiece.

-- Ashley Rininger, the youngest player on the 2011-12 Liberty roster, was 4.5 months away from turning two years old when the most recent Liberty vs. Virginia-Wise matchup took place.

A Look Back at Friday's Game at North Carolina A&T

-- Liberty sliced a 12-point deficit to one but could not complete the comeback.

-- North Carolina A&T improved to 39-5 at home since the start of the 2007-08 season.

-- The three-point line was the difference in the game, as North Carolina A&T shot 52.9 percent (9-of-17) while Liberty went just 1-of-13 (7.7 percent) from beyond the arc.

-- North Carolina A&T's 81 points were the most Liberty has given up since an 81-66 loss to No. 17/17 St. John's on Dec. 28, 2010.

-- Liberty had won seven straight matchups with the Aggies, before North Carolina A&T posted its first win over the Lady Flames since Feb. 15, 1996.

-- Liberty outrebounded its 30th straight opponent, nearly doubling up North Carolina A&T on the boards, 49-25.

-- Avery Warley made all eight of her field goals while scoring a team-high 18 points. It was the fifth time in her career that she has shot 100 percent from the field while taking at least five attempts.

-- Devon Brown's 14 points pulled her to within 32 of the 1,000-point barrier.

-- Neither Catherine Kearney nor LaKendra Washington had scored a point this season before Friday, but both provided a spark off the bench.

-- Kearney scored the first 11 points of her collegiate career, while Washington added 11 points in 12 minutes of action during her first appearance of the 2011-12 season.

Great Expectations

Expectations are high around the Big South Conference for Liberty's 2011-12 campaign. The Lady Flames were a near-unanimous pick to win the conference title, Avery Warley was voted Big South Preseason Player of the Year and Devon Brown joined Warley on the preseason All-Big South roster.

Great Expectations, Part 2

-- For the second straight year, Liberty was ranked in the CollegeInsider.com Women's Mid-Major Top 25 preseason poll. The only Big South team to appear in the preseason poll, the Lady Flames checked in at No. 20 to start the year and are currently ranked No. 18.
