Liberty (10-8, 7-2 Big South) will play host to Gardner-Webb (13-6, 7-2 Big South) Tuesday at 7 p.m. for a battle of Big South co-leaders at the Vines Center. Gardner-Webb won the teams' first meeting this season, 61-57, on Dec. 2 in Boiling Springs, N.C.

The "Starting Five" - Liberty's Top Storylines

- 1) It will be a "Super Tuesday" in Big South women's basketball, with two head-to-head matchups between the conference's four co-leaders. In addition to the Liberty-Gardner-Webb clash, Presbyterian will travel to UNC Asheville on Tuesday.
- 2) Liberty and Gardner-Webb are two of the hottest teams in the Big South right now. The Lady Flames have won three straight games and are 7-1 in their last eight outings, while the Runnin' Bulldogs are riding a six-game winning streak. Liberty has won four straight meetings with Gardner-Webb at the Vines Center and 17 straight home games versus Big South opponents.
- 3) Gardner-Webb will try to become the fourth Big South team to sweep the two-game regular-season series from Liberty during Carey Green's 17 seasons as head coach. Gardner-Webb previously accomplished the feat in 2009-10.
- 4) 10 of the 18 all-time meetings between Liberty and Gardner-Webb have been decided by 10 points or fewer, including three of the last four matchups.
- 5) Catherine Kearney continues to step up in the absence of injured teammate Ashley Rininger. She scored 20 points at Longwood on Sunday and is averaging 15.5 ppg in the last eight games with Rininger out of the lineup.

Notes and Anecdotes

- Gardner-Webb defeated Liberty, 61-57, in both teams' Big South opener, Dec. 2 in Boiling Springs, N.C. The Runnin' Bulldogs forced 31 turnovers by the Lady Flames in a game which saw nine ties and 13 lead changes. Candace Brown scored 10 of her game-high 17 points in the fourth quarter for Gardner-Webb. Sadalia Ellis tallied all 12 of her team-leading points after halftime for the Lady Flames.

- On Tuesday, the Runnin' Bulldogs will attempt to join Gardner-Webb (2009-10) and High Point (2006-07 and 2013-14) as the only Big South teams to sweep the two-game regular-season series from the Lady Flames in Carey Green's 17 seasons at Liberty.

- Gardner-Webb is currently riding a six-game winning streak, which has lifted the Runnin' Bulldogs into a share of the Big South lead.

- The quartet of Olivia Parker, Candace Brown, Alexis Hill and Tierra Huntsman has combined for 78.2 percent of Gardner-Webb's points this season.

- 10 of the 18 all-time meetings between Liberty and Gardner-Webb have been decided by 10 points or fewer, including three of the last four matchups.

- Gardner-Webb head coach Rick Reeves previously served as Liberty's head coach for nine seasons (1990-91 through 1998-99), leading the Lady Flames to their first three Big South Conference titles (1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99 seasons).

A Look Back at the Lady Flames' 72-67 Victory at Longwood

• Liberty was able to recover from a 10-point first-half deficit during Sunday afternoon's contest at Longwood, thanks in large part to its starting post players, Catherine Kearney (20 points) and Katelyn Adams (11 points, 12 rebounds).

• The Lady Flames survived a wild final minute to post a 72-67 victory inside Willett Hall.

• Kearney (8-8) and Adams (5-5) made all 13 of their field goal attempts, helping the Lady Flames shoot 55.1 percent (27-of-49) from the field and enjoy a 38-10 advantage inside the paint.

• Mickayla Sanders chipped in 15 points and Liberty made 9-of-10 free throw attempts during the final 2:29 of the Lady Flames' third straight win and seventh victory in their last eight outings.

• The Lancers hit a season-high 11 three-pointers on the afternoon and scored 11 points during the final 47.3 seconds, trimming a 15-point deficit to five.

• Kearney's 20-point game was her fourth of the season. She is the first Lady Flame to take seven or more field goals without a miss since Avery Warley went 8-for-8 from the field at North Carolina A&T on Nov. 18, 2011.

• Adams' double-double was her second of the season and the 11th of her career.

It's Been a While

• Liberty's 49-43 win at Radford on Jan. 2 marked the first time the Lady Flames have won a game when scoring fewer than 50 points since a 45-43 triumph at Virginia Tech on Dec. 30, 2008.

• The Lady Flames got off to their worst start through 10 games (3-7) since the 2008-09 team also opened up 3-7. However, that is not necessarily a bad sign, as both Liberty teams to start 3-7 or worse under Carey Green have reached the NCAA Tournament.

• The Lady Flames have already been outrebounded more times this season (4) than during the entire 2014-15 campaign (3).

• The Lady Flames' 60-42 setback at Presbyterian was their first double-digit loss to a Big South opponent since March 3, 2007 at Radford.

• Liberty's 36-point loss (92-56) to Seton Hall on Dec. 12 was its largest margin of defeat in Vines Center history. The facility opened in 1990.

Lady Flames' Big 3

Liberty's roster features a trio of redshirt seniors standing 6-4 or taller, including 6-6 Catherine Kearney, 6-5 Katelyn Adams and 6-4 Ashley Rininger. The Lady Flames are one of nine NCAA Division I women's basketball programs featuring three players who stand 6-4 or taller, including the only such squad in the Big South.

The other eight teams with at least three 6-4 players include Baylor, Duke, Oklahoma, Oregon State, South Carolina, Texas, Utah State and West Virginia.

Veteran Squad

Liberty boasts a significant amount of experience this season, including three redshirt seniors (Katelyn Adams, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger), two seniors (Sadalia Ellis and Jaymee Fisher-Davis), a redshirt junior (Mikal Johnson) and two juniors (Audrey Rettstatt and Mickayla Sanders).

• Three Lady Flames (Adams, Kearney and Rininger) have already graduated with bachelor's degrees, and Rininger has additionally completed a master's degree.

The Lady Flames are 102-1 under head coach Carey Green when making at least 50 percent of their field goals, including 2-0 this season. Liberty has won the last 29 times it has shot 50 percent or better, since an 83-77 loss to Kentucky in the first round of the 2010 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship (March 20, 2010).

The Container is Half Empty

Tradition of Excellence

- The Lady Flames have recorded 19 straight winning seasons. The streak started in 1996-97, the first year the Lady Flames won the Big South Championship title. Liberty is one of only 12 NCAA Division I women's basketball programs with an active streak of 19+ consecutive winning seasons.

- Liberty has posted eight straight 20-win seasons and 17 20-win campaigns in the last 19 years.

- Liberty has notched 16 consecutive seasons with 10+ Big South wins.

- After earning their 15th Big South regular-season title in 18 years, the 2014-15 Lady Flames claimed their 16th Big South Championship crown in 19 seasons.

No Easy Games

Liberty's first 10 opponents this season boasted a combined record of 37-10 at the time of the meeting. They included three nationally ranked teams (No. 11/14 Ohio State, No. 16/15 California and No. 13/11 Duke), marking the first time since 2010-11 that the Lady Flames have faced three Top 25 squads during the regular season.

The Lady Flames also squared off against a team which has spent time in the Top 25 in 2015-16 (Seton Hall), NC State of the ACC and two of the CAA's top squads in Elon and James Madison during their daunting nine-game non-conference slate.

Eight of Liberty's nine non-conference opponents made postseason appearances last season, including the NCAA Division I (James Madison, Ohio State, California, Seton Hall and Duke), WNIT (Elon and NC State) and NCAA Division II (Shepherd) Championships.
