**Today's Game**

Liberty (11-8, 8-2 Big South) will host a rematch of the 2015 Big South Women's Basketball Championship title game Saturday at 2 p.m., when High Point (7-12, 6-4 Big South) visits the Vines Center. Both teams will open the second half of their Big South Conference schedule with their first of two meetings in 25 days.

**The "Starting Five" - Liberty's Top Storylines**

- 1) Liberty has won four games in a row and is 8-1 in its last nine games, moving into a tie for first place in the Big South standings. Meanwhile, High Point is 4-1 in its last five outings.
- 2) The Lady Flames have won 18 straight home Big South games. However, the Panthers were the last visiting Big South squad to leave the Vines Center with a win, exactly two years ago today (Jan. 30, 2014). The road team has won 10 of the last 13 Liberty-High Point clashes played at either the Vines Center or Millis Center.
- 3) Liberty's five seniors have scored 63.4 percent of the team's points this season. Conversely, High Point's seven freshmen have accounted for 57.5 percent of the Panthers' points.
- 4) The Lady Flames have gotten a lift from a freshman of their own. Liberty is 4-0 since Brooke Alexander joined the starting lineup, and the Texan is coming off of a career-high 11-point output against Gardner-Webb.
- 5) Reigning Big South Player of the Week Catherine Kearney is averaging 15.9 ppg over the last nine games, including a 19-point, 11-rebound effort versus Gardner-Webb.

### Notes and Anecdotes

- Saturday's game will mark the first matchup between Liberty and High Point since the Lady Flames posted a 74-64 win over the Panthers in the 2015 Big South Championship title game in Conway, S.C. on March 8, 2015. Only three High Point players who appeared in that contest are still on the roster, including Kaylah Keys, Kat Harris and Maja Michalska.

- Keys, a 5-5 junior guard, paces the Panthers and ranks third in the Big South with 14.2 ppg. She is the leading active scorer among conference players with 1,289 career points.

- Harris' last-second game-winning layup at Radford on Tuesday lifted the Panthers to their fourth win in their last five outings.

- Four of High Point's top six scorers are freshmen, including Emma Bockrath (9.2 ppg), Lindsey Edwards (8.6), Haleigh Hatfield (7.3) and Shea Morgan (6.6). The Panthers' seven freshmen are scoring 57.5 percent of the team's points this season.

- The road team has won 10 of the last 13 Liberty-High Point contests played at either the Vines Center or the Millis Center. The Panthers were the last visiting Big South team to win in Lynchburg, notching a 94-89 double overtime win on Jan. 30, 2014.

- Nine of the last 13 matchups between Liberty and High Point have been decided by single digits, including a pair of overtime contests.

## A Look Back at the Lady Flames' 73-51 Victory Over Gardner-Webb

• In a battle between Big South co-leaders Tuesday at the Vines Center, Liberty scorched the nets during a 30-point first quarter and never looked back on the way to their fourth straight win.

• Reigning Big South Player of the Week Catherine Kearney (19 points, 11 rebounds) excelled once again in a 73-51 victory for the Lady Flames over Gardner-Webb.

• Liberty shot 65 percent (13-of-20) from the field, while jumping out to a 30-16 lead after 10 minutes.

• Meanwhile, the Lady Flames nullified any chance of a Gardner-Webb comeback by holding the Runnin' Bulldogs to 26.8 percent (19-of-71) field goal shooting on the night.

• Liberty is now tied with UNC Asheville for first place in the conference standings after recording its 18th straight home win over a Big South opponent.

• The Runnin' Bulldogs' four leading scorers on the season (Olivia Parker, Candace Brown, Alexis Hill and Tierra Huntsman) shot a combined 7-of-33 on the night.

• Liberty won the rebounding battle for the sixth straight game, 56-38. The Lady Flames also committed a season-low 12 turnovers, after totaling a season-high 31 miscues during its first matchup with Gardner-Webb this season.

## Shaking Things Up

Head Coach Carey Green has used eight different starting lineups during this season's first 19 games. The Lady Flames have eclipsed the number of starting lineups they used during the entire 2014-15 season (7), and 11 different players have started this year.

## It's Been a While

• Liberty's 49-43 win at Radford on Jan. 2 marked the first time the Lady Flames have won when scoring fewer than 50 points since a 45-43 win at Virginia Tech on Dec. 30, 2008.

• The Lady Flames got off to their worst start through 10 games (3-7) since the 2008-09 team also opened up 3-7.

• The Lady Flames' 60-42 setback at Presbyterian was their first double-digit loss to a Big South opponent since March 3, 2007 at Radford.

• Liberty's 36-point loss (92-56) to Seton Hall on Dec. 12 was its largest margin of defeat in Vines Center history. The facility opened in 1990.

## Lady Flames' Big 3

Liberty's roster features a trio of redshirt seniors standing 6-4 or taller, including 6-6 Catherine Kearney, 6-5 Katelyn Adams and 6-4 Ashley Rininger. The Lady Flames are one of nine NCAA Division I women's basketball programs featuring three players who stand 6-4 or taller, including the only such squad in the Big South.

The other eight teams with at least three 6-4 players include Baylor, Duke, Oklahoma, Oregon State, South Carolina, Texas, Utah State and West Virginia.

## Veteran Squad

Liberty boasts a significant amount of experience this season, including three redshirt seniors (Katelyn Adams, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger), two seniors (Sadalia Ellis and Jaymee Fisher-Davis), a redshirt junior (Mikal Johnson) and two juniors (Audrey Rettstatt and Mickayla Sanders).

• Three Lady Flames (Adams, Kearney and Rininger) have already graduated with bachelor's degrees, and Rininger has additionally completed a master's degree.

Liberty has outrebounded 15 of 19 opponents this season, including six in a row. The Lady Flames have climbed to No. 28 nationally with a +8.0 rebound margin.

## The Container is Half Full

The Lady Flames are 102-1 under head coach Carey Green when making at least 50 percent of their field goals, including 2-0 this season. Liberty has won the last 29 times it has shot 50 percent or better, since an 83-77 loss to Kentucky in the first round of the 2010 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship (March 20, 2010).

## The Container is Half Empty

Liberty had held 69 straight opponents below 50 percent shooting from the field before No. 16/15 California shot 51.9 percent (28-of-54) against the Lady Flames on Nov. 28 in Las Vegas. Most recently, the Lady Flames' last 10 foes have been held below the 50 percent mark.

### Tradition of Excellence

- The Lady Flames have recorded 19 straight winning seasons. The streak started in 1996-97, the first year the Lady Flames won the Big South Championship title. Liberty is one of only 12 NCAA Division I women's basketball programs with an active streak of 19+ consecutive winning seasons.

- Liberty has posted eight straight 20-win seasons and 17 20-win campaigns in the last 19 years.

- Liberty has notched 16 consecutive seasons with 10+ Big South wins.

- After earning their 15th Big South regular-season title in 18 years, the 2014-15 Lady Flames claimed their 16th Big South Championship crown in 19 seasons.

### No Easy Games

Liberty's first 10 opponents this season boasted a combined record of 37-10 at the time of the meeting. They included three nationally ranked teams (No. 11/14 Ohio State, No. 16/15 California and No. 13/11 Duke), marking the first time since 2010-11 that the Lady Flames have faced three Top 25 squads during the regular season.

The Lady Flames also squared off against a team which has spent time in the Top 25 in 2015-16 (Seton Hall), NC State of the ACC and two of the CAA's top squads in Elon and James Madison during their daunting nine-game non-conference slate.

Eight of Liberty's nine non-conference opponents made postseason appearances last season, including the NCAA Division I (James Madison, Ohio State, California, Seton Hall and Duke), WNIT (Elon and NC State) and NCAA Division II (Shepherd) Championships.
