10:15-12:05 Students will review during this time for their English and math exams on Tuesday and Wednesday. They will finish their “Treasures of the Snow” unit on Thursday by watching the movie.

7th Grade

- All seventh grade students will be taking their exams using the “typical” upper school schedule. (see below). Students will be taking **Math**, **English**, **Civics**, and **Science** exams.
- If a student does not have an exam during an exam period, the student is not required to be at school. If the student is at school during an exam period where they do not have an exam, they will be required to attend a study hall. *Main Street and other parts of the campus are not an option for students who do not have an exam.*

8th Grade

- All eighth grade students will be taking exams using the “typical” upper school schedule provided below.
- If a student does not have an exam during an exam period, the student is not required to be at school. If the student is at school during an exam period where they do not have an exam, they will be required to attend a study hall. *Main Street and other parts of the campus are not an option for students who do not have an exam.*

Exam Day Schedule (7th and 8th Grade): May 26

Exams follow student schedules by period. Tuesday – 1st and 2nd period, Wednesday – 3rd and 4th period, Thursday – 5th and 6th period, and Friday – 7th period.

*Students who need to make up exam(s) due to illness will do so on Friday. Make-up exams will be taken with the teacher whose exam they need to make up.

**Per the Student Handbook: all students are expected to take their exams during the scheduled exam time. Personal conflicts that require an exam to be taken at a time other than the scheduled exam period must be approved by the principal. A \$50 fee will be assessed for each approved makeup exam.
