1. **How much does it cost to participate in the Hockey Recruitment Camp?**
 - a. \$150

2. **When do I pay and what methods of payment do you take?**
 - a. Payment is due in full via credit card at the time of online registration
3. **When to travel?**
 - a. Arrive in time for check-in on Thursday, May 20th at 7am-9am
 - b. Players are welcome to depart following their last game Friday
4. **Where do I go for check-in?**
 - a. LaHaye Ice Center Lobby
5. **What time is check-in?**
 - a. Thursday, May 20th 7am-9am
6. **What is the competition like?**
 - a. Ages 15 – 20 are in the camp. Groups are based off age and level of play.
 - b. A wide variety of players come from all across North America playing for Tier 1-3, Junior A-C organizations, Club and High Schools. Current Liberty Hockey players.
 - c. Former leagues represented: USHL, NAHL, BCHL, AJHL, MJHL, SJHL, CCHL, OJHL, GOJHL, NCDC, NCAA DIII, NA3HL, USPHL, EHL, High School, Club A – AAA
7. **What do I need to bring?**

 - c. Clothes for 2 days.
