

Post-9/11 GI Bill® Eligibility Statement

The Post-9/11 GI Bill Eligibility Statement allows for advanced credit to be posted to your account before actual payment has been received from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). This will enable you to complete Financial Check-in with the projected assistance of the GI Bill. For students who are 100% eligible, this includes credit for the Yellow Ribbon Program, if you are eligible.

In order to receive advanced credit, we must know your student ID, percentage of eligibility, estimated months remaining, and effective semester for your GI Bill. This will help us to accurately project your GI Bill credit to your account, while we wait for the VA to send payment. If you have a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from VA, you may send in a copy of that document in place of filling out this form.
