

BSN Nursing Sophomore Summer Accelerated Program and Spring Summer Accelerated Program

The School of Nursing requires an additional application from Liberty University. This application allows the student to be accepted into Gate 1 (continuance in the School of Nursing curriculum). The Sophomore Summer Accelerated and Spring Summer Accelerated programs are designed for students who already have a degree or transfer students who have completed 2 years of college level work.

Sophomore Summer Accelerated – Applications are open on our website www.liberty.edu/nursing December 1 through February 15. The program consists of the 4 sophomore nursing classes. Fifty students are selected for the summer program and the classes are taught as intensives over an 8 week time frame typically beginning the week following graduation at Liberty University. Students who are successful with a “C” or better in these classes will enter into the junior year in the fall semester.

Spring Summer Accelerated – Applications are open on our website www.liberty.edu/nursing August 1 through October 1. Students selected for this program will enroll in NURS 200 and NURS 210 classes spring semester and the NURS 221 and NURS 225 classes in the summer semester as intensives. These classes will be taught over a 5 week time-frame. Students who are successfully complete nursing classes with a “C” or better will enter into the junior year in the fall semester.

Requirements:

- Minimum cumulative 3.25 GPA (all college course work including dual enrollment in high school)
- 55 transferable credits to the Nursing Degree Completion Plan
- Must have prerequisites completed by the end of the semester prior to starting the program.

The prerequisites are:

BIOL 213/214 & 215/216 - Anatomy & Physiology I & II (Lecture/Lab)

CHEM 107 - General/Organic Chemistry

BIOL 203 - Microbiology

NURS 101 - Introduction to Nursing*

NURS 105 - Medical Terminology*

NURS 115 – Sciences in Nursing (Pathophysiology)

- Complete entrance test by the application deadline
- Liberty University Registrar will determine classes that transfer in. The School of Nursing will determine if nursing classes taken elsewhere will transfer in.

*These classes can be completed the first semester at Liberty University if not available at your school.

Students can also apply to take senior nursing classes as intensive the summer between junior and senior year. Those students will finish senior year in the fall and graduate in December. Please visit www.liberty.edu/nursing for more information.
