

BSN Nursing Sophomore Spring Fast Track & Sophomore Summer Fast Track Program

The School of Nursing requires an additional application from Liberty University. This application allows the student to be accepted into Gate 1 (continuance in the School of Nursing curriculum).

The Sophomore Spring Fast Track and Sophomore Summer Fast Track programs are designed for students who already have a degree or transfer students who have completed at least 55 credits which transfer in and can be applied to the BSN Degree Completion Plan.

Sophomore Spring Fast Track:

Applications are open from **August 1 through October 1**. www.liberty.edu/nursing

Students selected for this program will be enrolled in NURS200 and NURS210 classes during the spring traditional semester and NURS221 and NURS225 classes in the summer semester as a 5-week intensive. Students who successfully complete all 200 level nursing classes with a "C" or better will enter the junior year in the fall semester.

Sophomore Summer Fast Track:

Applications are open from **December 1 through February 15**. www.liberty.edu/nursing

Students selected for this program will be enrolled in all 4 sophomore nursing classes (NURS200, NURS210, NURS221, NURS225) over an 8-week intensive typically beginning the week following graduation at Liberty University. Students who are successful with a "C" or better in all 200 level classes will enter the junior year in the Fall semester.

Eligibility Requirements:

- a. Minimum cumulative 3.25 GPA (all college course work including dual enrollment in high school). **Note:** In addition to the cumulative GPA requirement when transferring in credits from outside Liberty, the **Liberty University portion** of the cumulative GPA must also be at least 3.25.
- b. Students with a **Liberty University** GPA of **3.35** will have direct entry into the program upon completion of the application and meeting **all** requirements below.
 - 55 transferable credits applied to the Nursing Degree Completion Plan
 - All prerequisites must be completed by the end of the semester prior to starting the program. All prerequisites must be completed in a **Residential** format (***In-Person***).

BIO213/214: Anatomy & Physiology I
BIO215/216: Anatomy & Physiology II
CHEM107: General/Organic Chemistry
NURS104** Introduction to Nursing/Medical Terminology
NURS115: Pathophysiology

- Complete HESI A2 by the application deadline. This exam is offered on campus during the first several weeks of each semester. (***Students with a 4-year bachelor's degree obtained in the U.S. are exempt***).
- Liberty University Registrar will determine classes that transfer in. The School of Nursing will determine if nursing classes taken elsewhere will transfer in.

** This class can be completed in the first semester at Liberty University if not available at your school and must be completed before beginning junior year.

Students can also apply to take Senior Nursing classes as intensive the summer between junior and senior year (Senior Summer). ***Students will receive all information for this opportunity when they begin NURS302.***
