- Bible: BIB0900 may be waived for students entering LUOA after the 9th grade.
- Health & PE: 2 credits including a minimum of 0.5 credits in each subject. B: Boys; G: Girls.
- Lang/FA/CTE: 2 credits of a lang, fine arts, or career & tech (no more than 1 credit of lang).⁸
- 22+ total credits plus 1 Bible credit for every year as a full-time LUOA student required for graduation.

- 2.0** Maximum dual enrollment credits that may be transferred.
- 3.0** Minimum LUOA grade point average to remain in program
- 2.0** Minimum dual enrollment grade point average
- Grad App** Must submit graduation applications within the semester of the anticipated graduation.
