- Bible: 1 credit for every year as a full-time LUOA student.
- Health & PE: 2 credits including a minimum of 0.5 credits in each subject.
- Lang/FA/CTE: 2 credits of a Foreign Lang, Fine Arts, or Career & Tech electives (no more than 1 credit of lang allowed).
- 22+ total credits plus 1 Bible credit for every year as a full-time LUOA student required for graduation.

#### Graduation Requirements

- 22 + Bible** Minimum credits.<sup>5</sup>
- Grade of D** Min grade to pass high school courses.
- Grade of C** Minimum grade required to apply upper-level dual enrollment courses.
- Sr Year** Must be full time at LUOA.
- 5.5** Credits must be taken at LUOA.
- 2.0** Maximum dual enrollment credits that may be transferred.
- 3.0** Minimum LUOA grade point average to remain in program
- 2.0** Minimum dual enrollment grade point average
- Grad App** Must submit graduation applications within the semester of the anticipated graduation.
