- 6. Health & PE: 2 credits including a minimum of 0.5 credits in each subject. B: Boys; G: Girls.
- 7. Lang/FA/CTE: 2 credits of a lang, fine arts, or career & tech (no more than 1 credit of lang).
- 8. 22+ total credits plus 1 Bible credit for every year as a full-time LUOA stu. required for grad.
