- 153 Total Credit Hours
- 120 Credit hours must be 100-400 level courses (NURS 500 & 503 included)
- 3.0 Overall grade point average required for **undergraduate** Degree
- 3.0 Overall grade point average required for **graduate** Degree
- 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be upper-level (300-400 level)
- Grade of 'C'** Minimum required for all **undergraduate** courses in the major
- Grade of 'B-'** Or higher required for all **graduate** courses, including NURS 500 and 503
- 50% Of the coursework (up to 76.5 credit hours) may be transferred if approved and allowable, including credit from an earned degree from Liberty University on the same academic level
- 46% Of the undergraduate courses in majors must be taken through Liberty University
- 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be taken through Liberty University
- Nursing** Courses taken through Liberty University which are more than **5 years** old may not be applied towards this degree. Students are required to repeat the course if it has exceeded the age limit
- 5 years** Degree must be completed within 5 years
- Grad App** Submission of Degree Completion Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date
