The add-on Algebra I endorsement is an option for:

(a) Teachers who hold a current teaching license in any subject area

(b) Teacher candidates who are enrolled in a teacher preparation program that leads to initial licensure in any subject area. This certificate provides eligibility to add an Algebra I endorsement to their initial license, certifying them to teach mathematics courses through Algebra I in grades 6-12.
