- 120 Credit hours must be 100-400 level courses (NURS 500 & 503 included)
- 3.0 Overall grade point average required for undergraduate Degree
- 3.0 Overall grade point average required for graduate Degree
- 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be upper-level (300-400 level)
- Grade of 'C' Minimum required for all undergraduate courses in the major
- Grade of 'B-' Or higher required for all graduate courses, including NURS 500 and 503 50% Of the coursework (up to 76.5 credit hours) may be transferred if approved and allowable, including credit from an earned degree from Liberty
 - University on the same academic level 46% Of the undergraduate courses in majors must be taken through Liberty University
 - 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be taken through Liberty University
