2021-2022 Certificate Completion Plan

Important: This certificate plan is effective for those starting in the fall 2021 through summer 2022. This certificate plan will remain in effect for students who do not break enrollment or who do not change certificates.

The **add-on physics endorsement** is an option for:

Teachers who wish to add on an endorsement to teach physics courses in grades 6-12.

- Teachers who are already licensed in another science discipline
- Teacher Candidates who are enrolled in a teacher preparation program that leads to initial licensure in another science discipline. This certificate provides eligibility to add a physics endorsement, certifying them to teach physics courses in grades 6-12.
