Graduation Requirements

- 153 Total Credit Hours
- 120 Credit hours must be 100-400 level courses (NURS 500 & 503 included)
- 3.0 Overall grade point average required for undergraduate Degree
- 3.0 Overall grade point average required for graduate Degree
- 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be upper-level (300-400 level)
- Grade of 'C' Minimum required for all undergraduate courses in the major
- Grade of 'B-' Or higher required for all graduate courses, including NURS 500 and 503
 - 50% Of Graduate Concentration taken through Liberty University
 - 46% Of the undergraduate courses in the major must be taken through Liberty University
 - 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be taken through Liberty University
 - Nursing Courses taken through Liberty University which are more than 5 years old may not be applied towards this degree. Students are required to repeat the course if it has exceeded the age limit
 - 5 years Degree must be completed within 5 years
 - Grad App Submission of Degree Completion Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date
