Graduation Requirements

Complete 30 hours

A minimum of 24 hours must be completed through Liberty, not to include credits from a prior degree earned through Liberty

A maximum of 6 hours of transfer credit, including credit from a degree on the same academic level previously earned through Liberty, may be applied to the degree 3.0 GPA

No more than one grades of C may be applied to the degree (includes grades of C+ &

No grade of D may be applied to the degree (includes grades of D+ and D-)

Thesis required (Minimum grade of B-)

Degree must be completed within 5 years

Submission of Graduation Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date

Program Offered in Online Format

All applicable prerequisites must be met

¹Once the student enters the Thesis Project phase, he/she must maintain continuous enrollment (Fall and Spring semesters excluding Summer semester) until all degree requirements are completed

²Students may take DMIN 885 a maximum of four times.
