 - 50% Of the coursework (up to 78 credit hours) may be transferred if approved and allowable, including credit from an earned degree from Liberty University on the same academic level
 - 46% Of the undergraduate courses in the major must be taken through Liberty University
 - 30 Credit hours of undergraduate courses must be taken through Liberty University
- Coursework Taken through Liberty University and is more than 5 years old may not be applied towards this degree. Students are required to repeat the course if it has exceeded the age limit
 - 5 years Degree must be completed within 5 years
 - Grad App Submission of Graduation Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date
