Complete 45 hours

A minimum of 33 hours must be completed through Liberty University, not to include credits from a prior degree earned through Liberty

A maximum of 12 hours of transfer credit, including credit from a degree on the same academic level previously earned through Liberty, may be applied to the degree

No more than two grades of C may be applied to the degree (includes grades of C+

No grade of D or below may be applied to the degree (includes grades of D+ & D-) Degree must be completed within 7 years

Submission of Graduation Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date

All Applicable prerequisites must be met

Students must complete 9 hours with a minimum grade of B in History and Philosophy of Worship (WRSP 502), Biblical Foundations of Worship (WRSP 510) and Building a Theology of Worship (WRSP 635) or their equivalents before the completion of 9 hours of DWS coursework ¹Any student who is not ready for enrollment in WRSP 890 after completing

WRSP 889 may be required, as determined by the student's thesis chair, to repeat WRSP 889 until deemed ready for enrollment in WRSP 890
