    Complete 30 hours
    A minimum of 24 hours must be completed through Liberty University, not to include credits from a prior degree earned through Liberty
    A maximum of 6 hours of transfer credit, including credit from a degree on the same academic level previously earned through Liberty, may be applied to the degree 3.0 GPA

    No more than one grade of C may be applied to the degree (includes grades of $\mathrm{C}+\&$ C-)
    No grade of D or below may be applied to the degree (includes grades of $\mathrm{D}+\& \mathrm{D}-$ )
    Degree must be completed within 5 years
    Submission of Degree Completion Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date
