Elementary Education: EDUC 539, 599, 632, 634, 636, & 656

Secondary Education: EDUC 539, 599, 625, 656 & 673

According to the Virginia Department of Education, an individual who holds a teaching license may add an additional endorsement to the license by passing Praxis Subject Assessment. This testing option does not apply to individuals who are seeking an elementary education endorsement.
