 $Complete\ 60\ hours$

A minimum of 21 hours must be completed through Liberty University, not to include from a prior degree earned through Liberty

A maximum of 39 hours of transfer credit, including credit from a degree on the same academic level previously earned through Liberty, may be applied to the degree

No grades lower than a B- may be applied to the degree

Successful defense of dissertation

Degree must be completed within 5 years

Submission of Degree Completion Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date
