Canadian Financial Support Verification

International students must prove the availability of funds to meet all estimated expenses **for one full academic year**. This applies to new students and current students applying to a new program. Steps 1-3 below must be completed in their entirety (or equivalent documents provided) for the student to be considered for admission:

1. Student Information (completed by student)
2. Parent/Sponsor Certification (completed by sponsor)
3. Official Bank Certification – (Step 3 completed by bank/financial institution, or Sponsor must provide a current bank statement indicating sufficient funds for the first year of study). Bank statements must be no more than six months old. **If a bank statement is provided, please black out account number prior to scanning and emailing or faxing it to us.**

Scholarships: The total cost for one year of undergraduate studies is approximately **\$28,430 US**. Liberty Champion Award is worth \$1,000 first year. Students are eligible to be awarded up to a \$3,000 Academic Scholarship per year based on academic performance. The actual amount of scholarship awarded will be determined at the time of admission. Therefore, an affidavit in the amount of **\$28,430** is sufficient, although the amount needed may actually be less. Scholarships require the student to be enrolled in 12 undergraduate hours or more each semester.

NOTE: Providing false information may jeopardize a student's visa status and/or admissions and financial aid status at Liberty University.
