- 1. Proof of finances** in the form of a bank statement from within the past 6 months. Must show current available balance and your sponsor's name.
- 2. Copy of passport photo page**
- 3. Copy of travel insurance policy** – You must purchase a travel insurance policy to cover you for any health issues that may arise while you are in the United States. The policy must include the following benefits:
 - a. Medical Evacuation
 - b. Repatriation of Remains
 - c. Minimum \$250,000 per injury or illness

Please note that preexisting conditions are generally not covered by travel insurance.
