

Faculty Research Presentation Award

These funds support travel to conferences for the purpose of presenting research, all related to developing an effective and well-informed undergraduate research program.

Faculty will be awarded up to \$2500.

Eligibility

- Applicant should be a full-time, contracted residential (LUR) or online (LUO) faculty member.
- Must be accepted/invited to present at a conference.
- Applicant/Principal Investigator (PI) should currently be involved in research mentorship or instruction. (Provide course number and description or description of research collaboration with students).

Evidence of Commitment to Research

- Provide a curriculum vitae that demonstrates specific examples of participation in research and scholarship and contributions to the applicant's field in these areas or the potential to contribute in the future.

Evidence of Growth in Faculty Ability to Influence Student Learning

- Articulate how the award will help the applicant enhance their research mentorship/instructional skills, capabilities, and knowledge.
- Provide an action plan on how the applicant will incorporate the knowledge and skills gained at this event into research instruction/mentorship.

Evidence of Real-World Impact

- Articulate how the proposed research presentation opportunity will assist the applicant in advancing the university's reputation, impacting society, and how this research applies to the industry.

Follow-Up Expectations

- The award recipient will need to submit a one-page Award Summary within four weeks of the research presentation event. This summary will need to detail what the PI has learned, how the PI will use the information in the class, research mentorship, etc.
- Please upload Award Summary into the Attachments Tab of the Cayuse Award Record. Your Department Chair must review and provide an evaluation statement included in the Attached Project Summary.

Sponsorship Acknowledgment

Any publication, presentation, public recital, exhibition, or other public display of the faculty's work made possible through a research award must include an appropriate acknowledgment of the sponsoring department i.e. the College of Osteopathic Medicine, The Office of Sponsored Programs & Research, Fulbright Program, or CTE.
