Description of Position

The High School Hero builds relationships with high school students through mentoring and tutoring during school day and after-school activities at Heritage High School or E. C. Glass High School. In addition, the High School Hero advocates for students and their success via constant interaction with students, educators, and families. Hours of Operation are typically between 8:00am-3:00pm, Monday-Friday.

The student will report to the Liberty University Federal Work Study Coordinator and Beacon of Hope Future Center Director. Students hired for this position will be employed by the Liberty University Financial Aid Office and located on-site at the center.

Job Responsibilities

- Attend all Beacon of Hope training sessions on cultural competence, positive youth development, and literacy intervention
- Provide tutoring services in the Future Center at assigned high school
 - Specific areas of interest include: math, science, foreign languages
- Mentor and build positive relationships with students
- Assist Beacon of Hope Future Center Director with other duties as assigned

Job Qualifications

Minimum:

- Federal Work Study eligibility
- 10 to 20 hours of work availability per week
- Must provide own transportation
- Must pass various background checks, including, but not limited to, a check at the time of initial employment and subsequent checks on behalf of the Federal Work Study Community Service

Preferred:

- At least a second-year student at Liberty University in good standing (no reprimands or suspensions).
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Pay Rate: \$14 per hour

Length of Employment: Immediate start lasting until the position is no longer a good fit for the student or the center. The student will be evaluated by the on-site supervisor on an annual basis at the end of the spring semester. Summer employment opportunities are also available.
