Description of Position

This position is to help support the program by providing administrative and clerical support to the Quality Assurance Team. The need is to fill gaps in our Directory, Electronic Health Records System, and Learning Management System in order to provide reports, process auditing, and to track patterns related to services provided to Adults with Development Disabilities served in Sponsored Residential Homes. The typical hours of operation are between 9am-4pm, Monday through Friday.

The student will report to the Liberty University Federal Work Study Coordinator and the HumanKind Quality Assurance Manager. Students hired for this position will be employed by the Liberty University Financial Aid Office and located onsite at the center.
