

### Responding to incidents involving the Liberty Way

When an alleged violation is reported, you will have the opportunity to discuss the situation and share your perspective.

#### THE ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR WILL:

- Gather information
- > Assess the impact
- > Review all relevant information with you
- > Determine if violations of the Liberty Way have occurred
- > Determine the appropriate course of action

#### YOUR OPTIONS:

- > Provide a Statement for Record (optional, but highly encouraged)
- Choose a support person for any meeting or phone conversation (optional)
- Physically/personally review all relevant information (may require a formal request)
- > Leave meetings at any time

**Please note** that the community standards process will proceed with all available information even if you choose not to participate.

#### **OUR EXPECTATIONS:**

- Promptly respond to calls and emails from our office (i.e., within 48 hours of initial contact)
- > Attend all requested meetings on time
- Communicate honestly and openly
- Communicate respectfully

#### **OUR GOALS:**

- Restore the Liberty community
- > Promote personal accountability and honesty
- > Encourage and empower wise decision-making
- Impact Liberty University positively

The Conduct Review Committee may review level 3 and 4 violations. The committee convenes once per week to assess violations and render decisions. If you are found responsible for a violation, the associate director will inform you of the violation(s) and sanctions.
